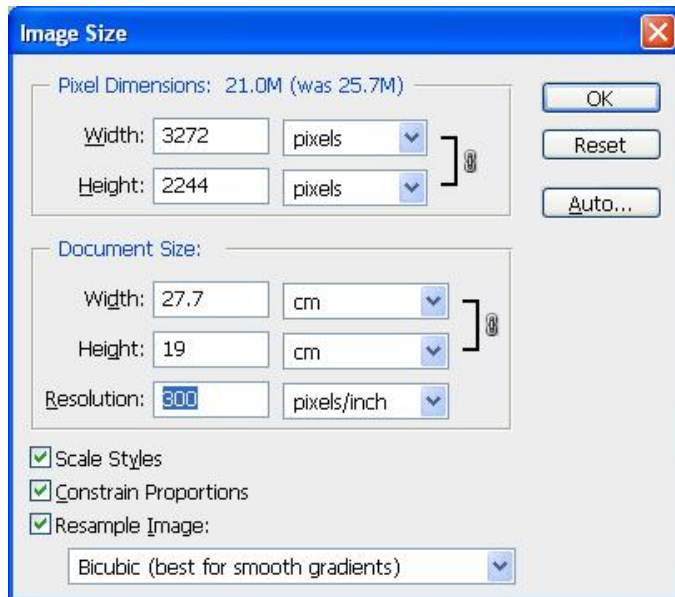
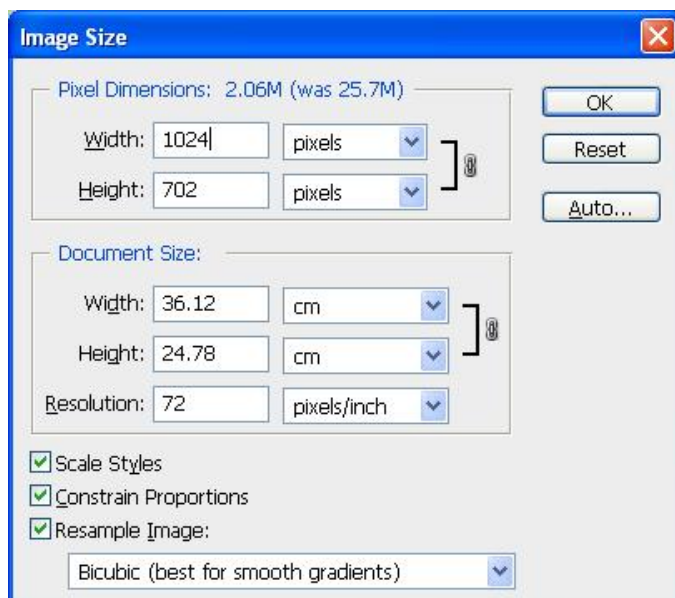


## PROJECTED IMAGES

- 1) Open a finished image in Photoshop, sharpened, cropped etc to your satisfaction, ideally should be saved at 240 – 300 ppi, but any size image will do.
- 2) Go to Image – Image Size and make sure all three resize boxes are ticked to maintain image proportions.



- 3) Change resolution to 72 pixels per inch.
- 4) Pixel dimensions in top box will change, highlight width image and change to 1024 pixels for a **Landscape** image only. Note only one dimension needs changing



- 5) Click OK, then show image at 100% on screen and go to Filter – Sharpen to re-sharpen image.
- 6) Save as a Jpeg at highest setting, in separate file for projected images.
- 7) For a **Portrait** image at step 4 highlight the height dimension and change this to 768 pixels. Note only one dimension needs changing.
